

Hamon's Restaurant The Parc Hotel, Cardiff



The Hamon's restaurant has been designed to attract an external clientele as well as hotel guests with entrances off both the street and the hotel lobby and has Cardiff's largest choice of wine and champagne. A feature glass wine rack on the back bar, visible from the lobby, presents a dramatic display of champagne, wine and spirits.

All the lighting within the restaurant is controllable and has been designed to allow for dimming and zoning, and is programmable to create various mood lighting effects. The bar has illuminated acrylic front panels and a black stone top which acts as a centre-piece to the restaurant.

A decorative wall lining together with strip up lighting along banquette seating provides definition to an awkward wall surrounding an unrelated fire escape stair from basement, which divides the front and back areas of the restaurant.

Throughout the design a palette of subtle colours and materials, together with feature lighting, are employed to give the restaurant a new interior of informal elegance.
