Nine Elms Regeneration, London SW8

Client: Sainsbury's

Team Leader on the regeneration of an existing Sainsbury site as part of the Vauxhall, Battersea and Nine Elms Opportunity Framework. Proposals integrate a larger store as well as introducing complimentary streets, squares and activity. Current designs show a mix of retail, office, mixed use and up to 800 units arrayed over a series of buildings. The design allows for height in a series of locations which are currently being agreed. The new store is seen as a flagship store setting a precedent and proposals such as the Northern Line extension are being considered.

Woodberry Down Kick Start Site 4, London N4

Client: Berkeley Homes

Planning Permission January 2011

Team leader on a 170 unit private residential scheme on the eastern reservoir. Project entails a mix of built form stepping across the site with an 18 storey tower to the eastern edge and a minor lantern feature to the west. Landscaping is integrated into the natural setting with carparking hidden in the basement. Designed in tandem with a further site providing social and intermediate units.

Tabard Square, Borough, London SE1

Client: Berkeley Homes (North East London) Ltd

Project Architect from inception through to execution on site, of this major regeneration project, comprising 572 residential units (of which 37% are affordable), together with a new supermarket and other commercial and retail units. The development comprises 3 separate buildings, primarily 6 to 8 storeys in height but including a 23-storey tower, arranged around a public square.

Woodberry Down Masterplan Phase / Kick Start Site 1 London N4

Client: Berkeley Homes

Involved in reviewing the first phase of sites for the redevelopment of the Woodberry Down Estate. Associate in charge of delivering the first site for the regeneration of Woodberry Down Estate. Project is a mixed use development of over 450 units of which 40% are affordable and the provision of retail / community facilities. The project comprises a series of 8 buildings from 4-12 floors with a tower form of 25 set in extensive landscaping to create both public and private amenity. Led process from inception through design, planning and now delivery.
